Into the Bible

- 3) Read Romans 7:25.** This verse points to the deliverance through Jesus Christ our Lord. How does this verse shape your understanding of victory over sin? In what practical ways can you rely on Christ's strength to overcome the challenges and temptations you face in your walk of faith?

- 4) How is the Holy Spirit leading you to apply God’s Word this week through what was heard in the sermon?**
