Getting Started

Into the Bible

1) Read Romans 6:11. "Paul calls believers to "consider yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus." What does it mean to "consider" or "reckon" yourself dead to sin? How can this mindset help you resist temptation?

Digging Deeper

- 1) **Read Romans 6:12-13.** Paul warns not to let sin reign in our bodies. What are some specific areas where you might be allowing sin to take control or have influence in your life? How can you actively present those areas to God as instruments of righteousness?
- 2) Read Romans 6:14. "Paul writes that "sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law but under grace." How does living under grace, rather than law, affect your motivation for living a holy life? In what ways does grace empower you to live differently?
- **3)** How is the Holy Spirit leading you to apply God's Word this week through what was heard in the sermon?
