Getting Started

List 1-2 aspects of the sermon that encouraged or challenged you.

Into the Bible

- 1) **Read Romans 4:1-5.** Paul emphasizes that Abraham was justified by faith rather than works. How does this challenge or affirm your understanding of how we can attain righteousness before God?

Digging Deeper

- 2) **Read Romans 9-12.** In verses 9-12, Paul discusses the significance of Abraham's faith being credited to him as righteousness before circumcision. What implications does this have for both Jews and Gentiles in understanding their relationship with God?

- 3) **Read Romans 4:11.** Reflecting on the idea presented in verse 11 that Abraham is the father of all who believe, what does it mean for you personally to live by faith? How can this understanding influence your daily life and interactions with others?

- 4) How is the Holy Spirit leading you to apply God's Word this week through what was heard in the sermon?
