## BIBLE STUDY & REFLECTION

*These questions reflect content from the sermon and are designed to help you study God’s word, meditate on God’s word, and apply God’s word to your own life.*

### Getting Started

1. List 1-2 aspects of the sermon that encouraged or challenged you.

### Into the Bible

2. Read Romans 3:3-4, 2 Timothy 2:13, & 1 Corinthians 10:31. Paul discusses God’s faithfulness in the face of human unfaithfulness. How can we hold onto the truth of God’s faithfulness when we struggle with our own trials, temptations, and shortcomings?

### Digging Deeper

Read Romans 3:1-2;19-20. In verses 1-2 and 19-20, Paul mentions the advantage of being a Jew and the value/role of the Law. How do you understand the role of the Law in revealing sin? What does this mean for believers today?

4. Read Galatians 2:16 & Philippians 3:9. In these verses, as well as Romans 3:19-20, Paul highlights that the Law makes us aware of sin but cannot justify us. What does justification by faith mean to you personally? How can this understanding change the way we approach our faith and our actions?

5. How is the Holy Spirit leading you to apply God’s Word this week through what was heard in the sermon?
